Human Life PAC Rules (Since 1980)

- All candidates **must submit a completed questionnaire at each election cycle** to receive an official assessment or endorsement.
- ***When an incumbent faces a pro-life challenger, previously endorsed pro-life incumbents take precedence over new candidates;**
- ***The new candidate is listed as "100% Agreement" status with Human Life PAC.**

The following candidates completed 13 questions. Answers not consistent with our position are ranked as indicated:

2 Missed: Near Agreement

3 Missed: Partial Agreement
